Supporter Form Requirements

This section should include specific examples of the applicant's accomplishments, their influence on the field, and the potential they hold for future contributions. The supporter should also reflect on the applicant's character and professional integrity, providing a well-rounded endorsement.

By adhering to these guidelines, the supporter ensures that the application process remains rigorous and that only the most deserving candidates are awarded Fellow Membership in the IATI.
